A Year of Multiplication: Our Vision for 2025

As we step into 2025, I can't help but feel an overwhelming sense of expectation. Since stepping into the role of Executive Director, I've been praying over what God has for Life Choices this year, and I believe He has made it clear—this will be a year of multiplication.

Multiplication of hope.

Multiplication of life.

Multiplication of strong families.

God is growing this ministry in ways that only He can, and I am honored to be part of what He is doing.

One of the biggest areas of focus this year will be Fatherhood. The statistics are undeniable—if a father is a committed believer, there is a 90%+ chance that his children will follow in faith. That means if we want to see lasting change, if we want to strengthen families and impact generations, we must reach fathers.

So this year, we are committing to engaging, equipping, and empowering men—helping them step into their role as spiritual leaders, protectors, and providers. We will be expanding resources, creating more mentorship opportunities, and ensuring that when men walk through our doors, they know they have a place here. Because strong fathers build strong families, and strong families change everything.

We are also introducing our new Life Lamb program. This beautiful initiative officially launched in January, and we just gave out our very first Life Lamb! These heartbeat-recording lambs are given to women who come in for an ultrasound, allowing them to hear their baby's heartbeat and take it home as a tangible reminder of the life growing within them. 95% of undecided women choose life after seeing their baby on an ultrasound, and now, with this keepsake in their hands, that life-affirming moment continues beyond our walls. Thanks to the overwhelming generosity of our supporters, many Life Lambs have already been donated, and we are excited to see this program bless even more women in 2025.

And perhaps the most exciting milestone of all—we are opening Redeeming Life Maternity Home. For women with nowhere else to turn, this home will be a place of refuge, restoration, and hope. Director Kimberly Merriman will be on-site to help these women grow, heal, and prepare for their future. Redeeming Life will provide expectant mothers with the support they need to build stability, find hope, and embrace the future God has for them. This has been a long-time prayer, and in 2025, it will become a reality. This year, we are believing for more. More lives saved. More families strengthened. More men stepping into their God-given roles as fathers.

But none of this is possible without you.

Your prayers, your generosity, and your faithfulness are the reason this ministry continues to grow. God is moving, and I am grateful beyond words to be walking into 2025 with this incredible Life Choices family.

Thank you for believing in this mission. Thank you for standing with us. I can't wait to see what God does next!
